Quigley v. Kemp, Docket. No. 43725

This case involves a thorny discovery dispute in a medical malpractice case. The Court held that a plaintiff must disclose the identity of a non-testifying medical expert who has been consulted by a testifying expert to familiarize the testifying expert with the applicable local standard of care. The Supreme Court vacated the Ada County district court's order, and the case was remanded.
