SUMMARY STATEMENT

Weymiller v. Lockheed Idaho Technologies, Docket No. 44109

In an appeal from the Industrial Commission of the State of Idaho, the Idaho Supreme Court reversed the Industrial Commission's holding that Penny Weymiller ("Weymiller") failed to prove her entitlement to additional medical care. The Idaho Supreme Court held that the Commission's failure to consider palliative care in the form of wrist braces as treatment is contrary to this Court's holding in *Rish v. Home Depot, Inc.*, 161 Idaho 702, 390 P.3d 428 (2017). Further, the Idaho Supreme Court held that sufficient uncontradicted evidence supported Weymiller's claim for replacement braces.
