SUMMARY STATEMENT

Sharon Wechsler v. Norman Wechsler, Docket No. 44297

In an appeal arising out of Bannock County, the Idaho Supreme Court affirmed the judgment of a district court. On appeal, Norman Wechsler argued that the district court: (1) abused its discretion by granting Sharon Wechsler's ("Sharon") motion to compel; (2) abused its discretion by appointing the ancillary receiver; (3) violated his constitutional rights; (4) made erroneous evidentiary holdings; (5) erred by holding that there was no conflict of interest between the ancillary receiver and Sharon; and (6) erred by holding him in contempt of court. The Idaho Supreme Court affirmed the judgment of the district court and awarded costs and attorney fees on appeal to Sharon.
