SUMMARY STATEMENT

John Doe and Jane Doe II v. John Doe I, Docket No. 44662

The Idaho Supreme Court affirmed the decision of a Canyon County magistrate judge terminating the parental rights of an incarcerated father to his minor child in contemplation of the child's adoption by her stepfather. The father was in prison on a murder conviction and would not be eligible for parole until after the child reached the age of majority. The Supreme Court affirmed the magistrate's determination that termination was in the best interest of the child.
