SUMMARY STATEMENT Lunneborg v My Fun Life - Docket No. 45200

The Idaho Supreme Court affirmed the judgment of the district court in this appeal of a breach of an employment contract case arising out of Kootenai County. Respondent claimed his employment contract entitled him to severance because he was by terminated by appellants without cause. The district court, sitting as the trier of fact, found that appellants did not have cause to terminate respondent and, therefore, awarded him \$60,000 in damages, which was trebled under the Idaho Wage Law Claims Act. Respondent was also awarded attorney fees and costs on appeal. The Court also affirmed the district court's judgment allowing respondent to pierce appellant My Fun Life's corporate veil, allowing respondent to collect his judgment against appellant sole shareholder and against his wife, personally.
