SUMMARY STATEMENT

George McGivney v. Aerocet, Inc. & State Insurance Fund Docket No. 45700

The Idaho Supreme Court affirmed the order of the Idaho Industrial Commission (Commission), which awarded George McGivney (McGivney) benefits for injuries he sustained to his left knee during his employment with two employers, Aerocet, Inc., (Aerocet) and Quest Aircraft (Quest). The Commission apportioned liability equally between Aerocet and Quest. The Supreme Court determined there was no error in consolidating the two worker's compensation claims against the two employers. The Supreme Court further held that the Commission did not err by declining to separately determine McGivney's disability in excess of impairment from his 2011 accident at Aerocet prior to his 2014 accident at Quest. The Supreme Court remanded the case to the Commission to enable it to calculate the amount due Quest's surety from Aerocet's surety for any amounts overpaid by Quest's surety.
