

## SUMMARY STATEMENT

*State v. Manzanares*, Docket No. 35703

In a 4-1 opinion, the Idaho Supreme Court affirmed the district court judgment entered upon a guilty plea to recruiting a gang member pursuant to Idaho Code section 18-8504(1)(a). The Supreme Court ruled that the statute was not unconstitutionally overbroad and did not encroach on her First Amendment right to free association. The Court also ruled that the lack of specificity in the reservations of her plea agreement and the nature of her *Alford* plea kept it from ruling on her issues regarding an *ex post facto* violation and unconstitutional challenge of the statute as applied to her conduct.
