

## SUMMARY STATEMENT

*Hopkins v. Pneumotech, Inc.*, No. 38354

The Supreme Court affirmed the Idaho Industrial Commission's decision to uphold the award of unemployment benefits to Pneumotech, Inc.'s former employee, Angela Hopkins. The Court found that (1) the Commission neither abused its discretion nor violated Pneumotech's right to due process in denying a request for a new hearing, and (2) substantial and competent evidence supported the Commission's finding that Hopkins was not terminated for misconduct.
