

SUMMARY STATEMENT

Jasso v. Camas County, Idaho, No. 37258

The Supreme Court upheld the district court's ruling that the Camas County Board of Commissioners' findings of fact and conclusions of law did not amount to a reasoned statement as required by I.C. § 67-6535 and that the lack of a reasoned statement violated the petitioners' substantial right to due process. This Court reversed the district court's award of attorney fees.
