

SUMMARY STATEMENT

TJT, Inc. v. Mori, No. 37805

The Supreme Court held that the district court erred in finding that the duration and geographic scope of a non-competition agreement violated California law. The Court reversed the summary judgment in favor of Mori, the person subject to the non-competition agreement, and remanded the case to the district court for a determination of whether the agreement could be “blue penciled” to make its geographic scope reasonable.
