Pursuant to Idaho Administrative Rule 59(g), the Idaho Supreme Court finds that there is a basis to conclude that STEPHEN F. ULLRICH is a vexatious litigant. A PROPOSED PRE-FILING ORDER was issued by this Court on March 13, 2013, allowing Stephen F. Ullrich fourteen (14) days to file a written response. Thereafter, a RESPONSE PRO SE with attachments, a MOTION FOR DECLATORY RULING OF DENIAL OF ACCESS TO COURT with attachments, a MOTION FOR DECLATORY RULING OF PROBABLE CAUSE OF DENIAL OF MEDICAL CARE with attachments, a MOTION TO COMPEL with attachment, a MOTION AND AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT FOR APPOINTMENT OF COUNSEL and a MOTION AND AFFIDAVIT FOR PERMISSION TO PROCEED ON PARTIAL PAYMENT OF COURT FEES (PRISONER) were filed by Stephen F. Ullrich on March 25, 2013. Therefore, after due consideration and good cause appearing,

IT HEREBY IS ORDERED that STEPHEN F. ULLRICH shall be prohibited from instituting any new litigation in any Idaho state court *pro se* without first obtaining leave from a judge of the court where the litigation is proposed to be filed.

This **ORDER** is supported by the following Findings:

- 1. STEPHEN F. ULLRICH's abuse of the Idaho judicial system has become a travesty;
- 2. STEPHEN F. ULLRICH has persistently wasted this Court's time, as well as the time of other courts, and has persistently filed litigation and motions to harass and maliciously injure Idaho citizens with frivolous litigation that is unsupported by existing law and does not provide any good faith argument for the extension, modification or reversal of existing law;

- 3. STEPHEN F. ULLRICH has persistently filed motions and briefs without any rational argument and are difficult, if not impossible, to understand;
- 4. STEPHEN F. ULLRICH's litigation tactics can only be interpreted as a means to harass; and
- 5. Within the last seven (7) years, STEPHEN F. ULLRICH has filed at least nineteen (19) civil lawsuits against parties in the courts of the State of Idaho.
