

SUMMARY STATEMENT

Nate v. Denney, Docket No. 45001-2017

The Idaho Supreme Court denied the Petitioner's Verified Petition for a Writ of Mandamus. This is an original action seeking a writ of mandamus compelling the Secretary of State to certify 2017 House Bill No. 67 as law because the Governor did not veto the bill and return it to the Secretary of State within ten days (excluding Sundays) after the legislature adjourned. We overrule *Cenarrusa v. Andrus*, 99 Idaho 404, 582 P.2d 1082 (1978), but hold that all parties are misconstruing Article IV, section 10, of the Idaho Constitution, and we deny the writ of mandate.
