

Idaho Court Administrative Rule 44. Nonjudicial Days
(a) Nonjudicial Days Enumerated The nonjudicial days for the state of Idaho are as follows:
(1) Every Sunday;
(2) January 1 (New Year's Day);
(3) July 4 (Independence Day);
(4) November 11 (Veteran's Day);
(5) December 25 (Christmas Day);
(6) Third Monday in January (Martin Luther King, Jr Idaho Human Rights Day
(7) Third Monday in February (Washington's Birthday);
(8) June 19 (Juneteenth);
(9) Last Monday in May (Decoration Day);
(10) First Monday in September (Labor Day);
(11) Second Monday in October (Columbus Day);



(9) Issue any emergency	y order	in any	civil or	criminal	case in the	discretion	of the	district _.	judge or
magistrate.									

Provided, the office of the clerk of the court shall be open to conduct business on a general election day.
