Only these pleadings are allowed in family law actions: (1) a petition; (2) an answer to a petition, which may include a counterclaim; (3) an answer to a counterclaim designated as a counterclaim; (4) an answer to cross claim; (5) a third-party petition; (6) an answer to third-party petition; and (7) if the court orders one, a reply to an answer. (b) Civil Protection Order Pleadings. Only these pleadings are allowed in civil protection order actions: (1) a petition; and

(2) an application for modification, termination or renewal of civil protection order.
