Idaho Misdemeanor Criminal Rule 17. Appeal to the District Court.

An appeal to the district court from a judgment of conviction or the suspension of a driver's license for a criminal offense may be taken within the time and processed in the manner prescribed for appeals from the magistrates division to the district court by the Idaho Criminal Rules; provided, an appeal from the suspension of a driver's license under I.C. Section 18-8002 may be taken within the time and processed in the manner prescribed for appeals from the magistrates division to the district court by the magistrates division to the district court by the Rules of Civil Procedure.
